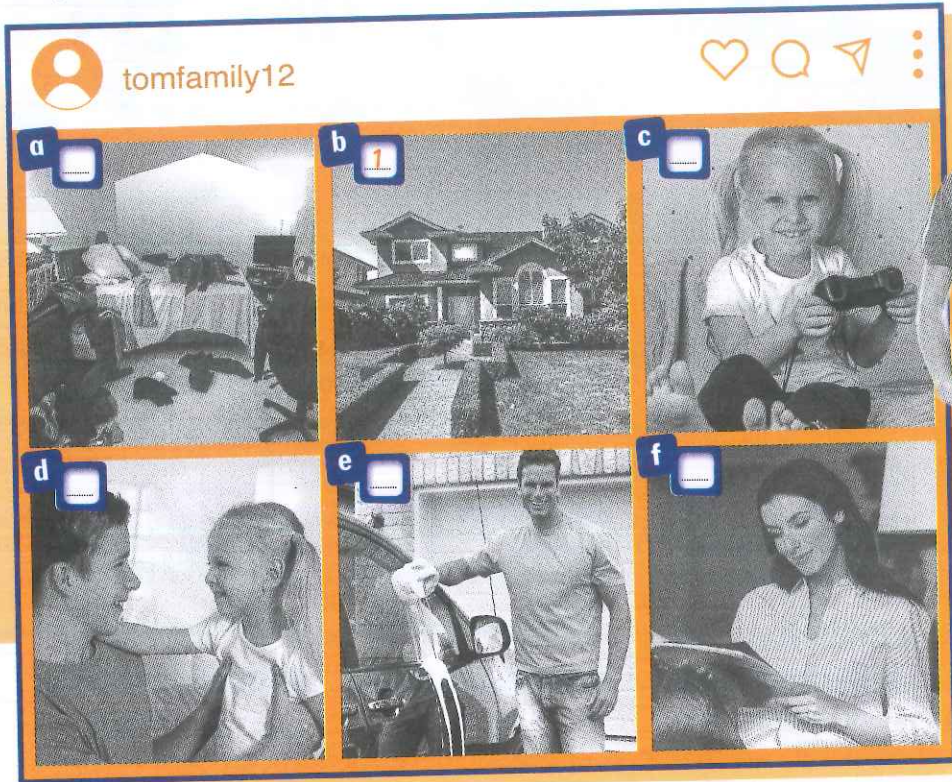

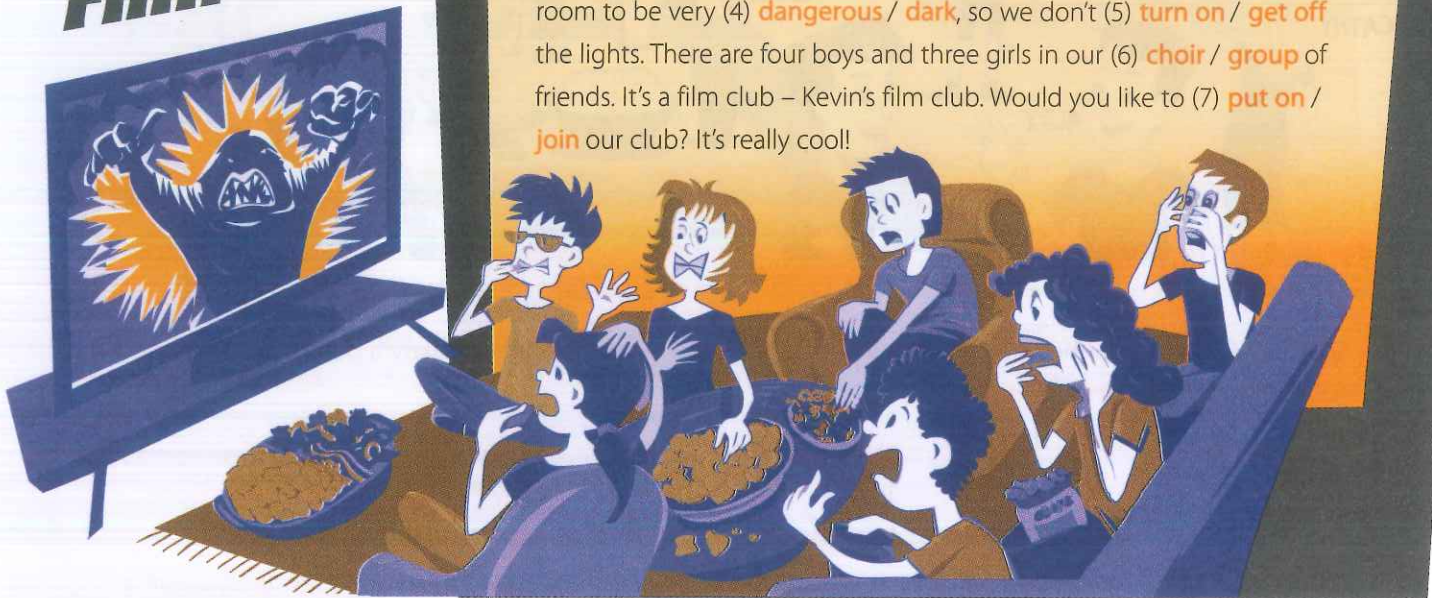

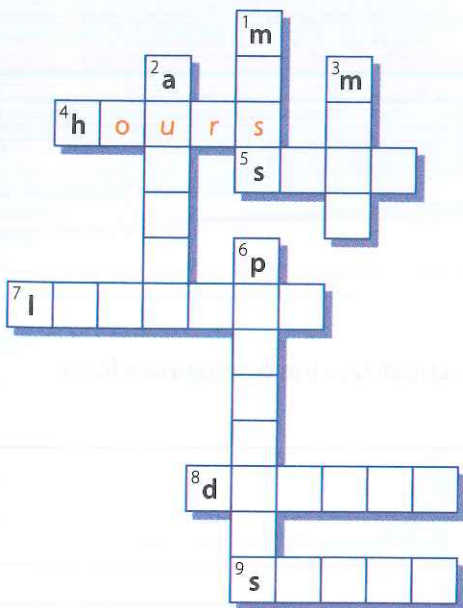

My School

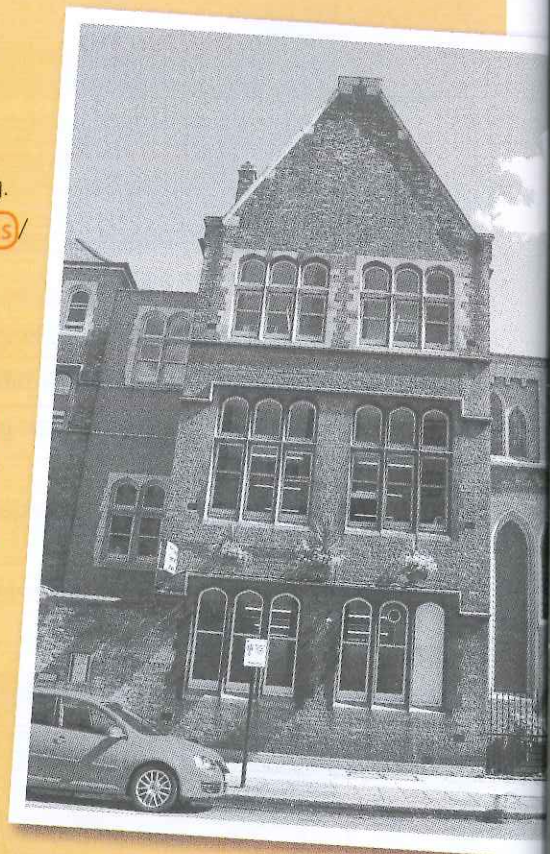
